

11th Biennial Hull-IHS Headache Meeting

Dear Colleagues,

I have pleasure in inviting you to attend the 11th Biennial National Meeting on Headache organised jointly by the International Headache Society (IHS) and the Department of Neurology Hull University Teaching Hospitals. The meeting runs for 4 days of which the last day is a public day to raise awareness of headache disorders in the general public. The first day is dedicated to primary and secondary care general physicians and allied healthcare professionals while days two and three are for the Neurologists and trainees in Neurosciences. The meeting attracts 16 External CME credits by the RCP (155596).

The Hull meeting is the biggest headache educational event in the UK. In 2025 we had 350 delegates from all over the UK and abroad. This year the 3rd Vicky Quarshie Memorial Lecture will be delivered by the president of the International Headache Society, Professor Mario Peres from Sao Paulo, Brazil, while Professor Rami Burstein (Harvard Medical School), Professor Peter Goadsby (UK), Professor Patricia Pozo Rosich (Spain), Professor Henrik Schytz (Denmark) and Professor Rigmor Jensen (Denmark) will be other invited guest speakers.

The meeting is pitched for general practitioners, general neurologists and trainees in neurology and headache. The meeting is supported by an unrestricted educational grant from Lundbeck UK. Refreshments and lunches are free of charge on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

The meeting is free to attend; however, the venue can only accommodate up to 350 delegates, and it is very likely that the event will be oversubscribed. To guarantee your place, I would advise reserving as early as possible to avoid disappointment. To guarantee a place, you can pay £30 via PayPal to fayyaz.ahmed@i-h-s.org. There will be conference dinner on Thursday 21st January at the Lazaat Restaurant open to all delegates to meet and interact with the experts and invited faculty. The cost will be £70 including soft drinks payable through PayPal. This is non-refundable.
